In the early days after being diagnosed with multiple food allergies, Naomi Antenucci decided to write a book to help her then 14 month old daughter better understand her allergies.

Naomi says “I thought the more she understood the safer for her and the easier it would be for me. I wanted it to be fun and enjoyable and show her that her allergies were only one part of who she is, and that everyone is different in some way. I wrote a book that doesn’t focus on any particular allergy, but the message behind it is one of safety, understanding and acceptance.

Kids who have allergies need to be safe, but they also need to know they are just like everyone else. It’s our job as parents to help make this happen. We can’t lock up every nut, egg and other allergen, but we can teach them to understand what is going on”.
